ENTRIES: The entry fee will be \$250.00 per team or \$25.00 per individual, if **paid by March 22nd (\$275/\$30 if paid after March 22nd**). Team fees will include a hat and lunch for Coaches. Please make checks payable to Jesuit Athletics. This meet has two Boys divisions, 6A and 5A & under, Varsity only. Entries must be submitted online at <u>tx.milesplit.com</u>. Contestants will be seeded according to times submitted. Contestants are limited to 3 running events and 5 total events.

Changes to your original entry form must be changed online at <u>tx.milesplit.com</u> & will be accepted until 6:00pm, Wednesday, March 19th. <u>No changes allowed after 6:00 pm Wednesday</u>. **Please delete any entries that you know will not compete prior to Wednesday**.

- <u>AWARDS</u>: Medals for first, second and third place finishers in all events. Batons for winning relay teams. Medals for 1st Place Team in each Division. **Medal winners will be escorted to the awards** stand immediately after the conclusion of each event.
- <u>RULES</u>: The meet will be governed by the National Federation of High School Association rules with UIL uniform modification (Male contestants must wear shorts over the one-piece suit or compression short).

Tape may be used to mark the track, HJ apron and other field event runways. Competitors shall remove all markings after competition.

High Jump starting height will be 5'8" and will rise in 2" increments.

Long and Triple Jump contestants will be allowed 3 jumps in the preliminary round. Eight finalists plus all ties for the 8th position will be allowed 3 additional jumps in the final round.

Pole Vault starting height will be 12' and will rise in 6" increments to 13'6". First Session will begin at 9:30 AM and stop after 13'6. The second session will start at 14'0" at 11:00 AM. Vaulters entering at the beginning of session II will be given a 40-minute warm-up period. 6A and 5A & Under Divisions jump together with places awarded by division.

Shot Put and Discus contestants will be allowed 3 throws in the preliminary round. Eight finalists plus all ties for the 8th position will be allowed 3 additional throws in the final round. Implements will be pooled.

Curve judges will be present for all races. Please make sure that your athletes understand the rules prior to racing.

Official timing will be fully automatic as times and places will be determined from the Finish Lynx System. The meet director will make all logistic decisions regarding placement of starting and finish lines, runway direction, and timing systems.

<u>Minimum Entry standards</u> are **20'0** for **Long Jump** and **40'0** for **Triple Jump**. <u>Minimum Entry standards</u> are **40'0** for **Shot Put** and **120'0** for **Discus**.

Minimum Entry standard for the 800m is 2:10.0 Minimum Entry standard for the 1600m is 5:00.0

800m, 1600m, 3200m, 4x400 and **DMR** races; 5A and 6A Divisions will be combined and seeded by time. Points and medals will be awarded in finish order by Division. The 3200m will be run Friday night. The 800m and 1600m will be run in two sections on Saturday with Section 1 in the morning preliminaries and Section 2 during the afternoon finals.

Audible speakers and radios will not be permitted in the stands, warm-up or competition areas.

COACHES There will be a Coaches reception from 7:00-8:00 in the school cafeteria. RECEPTION

TEAM Team camps can be set up under the Home (West side) Stands, no Tents are allowed on turfed areas or <u>CAMPS</u> in the Stands.

WARM-UP Warm up will be on the Lower field, **NO Athletes or Coaches** will be on the infield. The track will be open from 7:00 until 8:25 and 1:30 until 2:15 for Relays teams to work on exchanges and marks.

HEATINGThe heating clerk & benches will be outside the Southeast corner of the track near the baseballCLERKstadium, the group will be walked to the starting line. No Bags will be allowed inside the track.

RELAY All members of relays teams must be checked in and will be walked to their exchange Zones. TEAMS:

- <u>MEALS</u>: A meal will be provided for coaches following completion of the morning preliminaries. Also, we will have a concession stand selling barbecue other types of nourishing "all day food".
- HEATPreliminary heat sheets will be available in the Coaches Packet online at www.JSRelays.org onSHEETS:Friday. Please make all entry changes, adds and deletes by 6:00 pm Wednesday, March 19th attx.milesplit.comFinals heat sheets will be available online after 1:30 pm on Saturday.

- EXPEDIENCY: Coaches, please have your athletes ready to cooperate with prelim heating clerks and event judges.

Athletes participating in simultaneous events are responsible for managing their time between events and reporting or returning to their respective competition venues when called to compete.
