**ENTRIES:** The entry fee will be \$20.00 per individual up to maximum of \$200.00 per team, if **paid by March 26<sup>th</sup> (\$225/\$25 if paid after March 26<sup>th</sup>)**. Team fee will include a hat and lunch for Coaches. Please make checks payable to Jesuit Athletics.

**Entries must be submitted online at [tx.milesplit.com](http://tx.milesplit.com).** Contestants are limited to 3 running events and 5 total events. Individual events are open to all-comers interested in competing with the best State, National and Area ranked athletes. Relay events (4x100, 4x200 & 4x400) are by invitation only.

Preliminary heats will be run as needed in the 100m, 200m, 400m, 100/300m hurdles. The 800m, 1600m, 3200m, and Relay events are one-heat finals only with no preliminary heats.

The 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m and 100/300m hurdles will be limited to sixteen contestants. Up to 24 contestants will be accepted in the 1600m, 3200m and field events. Relays are by invitation only (finals only)

**Entry Changes can be made through 12:00pm (noon) Monday, 3/22/20** with the **final start list** published on [JSRelays.org](http://JSRelays.org) after 5:00 pm, Monday, March 22<sup>nd</sup>

Contestants will be seeded according to times submitted and cross referenced to previous published times on the [Area Leaders List](#) and MileSplit State and National rankings to ensure the best possible competition in all races.

**EVENTS:** The following events will be contested;

**AWARDS:** Medals for first, second and third place finishers in all events. Batons for winning relay teams. Medals for 1<sup>st</sup> Place Team. **All medals will be available for pickup throughout the day at awards table located at the Northwest Pavilion after conclusion of each event.**

RULES: The meet will be governed by the National Federation of High School Associations rules.  
Tape may be used to mark the track, HJ apron and other field event runways: No chalk is permitted  
Competitors shall remove all markings after competition.  
High Jump starting height will be 4'8" and will rise in 2" increments.  
Long and Triple Jump contestants will be allowed 3 jumps in the preliminary round. Eight finalists will be allowed 3 additional jumps in the final round.  
Pole Vault starting height will be 10' and will rise in 6" increments.  
Shot Put and Discus contestants will be allowed 3 throws in the preliminary round. Eight finalists will be allowed 3 additional throws in the final round. Implements will be pooled.  
Curve judges will be present for all races. Please make sure that your athletes understand the rules prior to racing.  
Official timing will be fully automatic as times and places will be determined from the Finish Lynx System. The meet director will make all logistic decisions regarding placement of starting and finish lines, runway direction, and timing systems.  
Audible speakers and radios will not be permitted in the stands, warm-up or competition areas.

COACHES RECEPTION There will be a Coaches reception from 7:00-8:00 in the school cafeteria

TEAM CAMPS Team camps can be set up in the Home (West side) Stands, no Tents are allowed on turfed areas or in the Stands.

WARM-UP Warm up will be on the Lower field, **NO Athletes or Coaches** will be on the infield. The track will be open from 7:00 until 8:25 and 1:00 until 2:15 for Relays teams to work on exchanges and marks.

HEATING CLERK The heating clerk & benches will be outside the Southeast corner of the track near the baseball stadium, the group will be walked to the starting line. **No Bags** will be allowed inside the track.

RELAY TEAMS: **All members of relays teams must be checked in and will be walked to their exchange Zones.**

MEALS: A meal will be provided for coaches following completion of the morning preliminaries. Also, we will have a full concession stand.
